VOLUNTEER GUIDELINES

- Give name of team when arriving to Fairgrounds— tell all of your vehicle drivers
- Supervise young children carefully!!!
- Don't leave any trash or tires collected on sides of roads -bring all to LA State Fairgrounds!
- Don't walk in streets or waterways (clean up on shoreline only)
- Don't pick up sharp or unidentifiable objects
- Pickup bagged trash by handles, not on sides of bags

What is the Great American Cleanup?

Keep America Beautiful Great American Cleanup is the nation's largest community improvement program. It involves 2.8 million volunteers across the United States. Its 500+ affiliates, like **Shreveport Green**, will rally hundreds of caring citizens to improve the city's environment. If you miss the city and parish-wide cleanup day, your group can still participate during the GAC period March 1 through May 31.

Typical One-Day Cleanup

- Over 900 volunteers participate on the day of the main event!
- Volunteers usually remove 40,000- 52,000 pounds of trash from streets, parks, roads, lakes, ponds, schools, and illegal dumpsites
- Tires, old furniture, appliances, and junk are often collected from roadsides and illegal dumpsites
- Over 25 miles of roadway are cleaned in the city
- At least 20 communities are impacted, including parish areas
- Volunteer ages are between 9-78 years old



COMMUNITY IMPACT:

1. Reduced amount of litter, tires, junk from lands and waterways;
2. Reduced potential for clogged storms drains
3. Enhanced beauty of city
4. Reduced potential for pollution of land and water
5. Increased awareness of the harm litter causes society

Who Can Participate?

Neighborhood organizations, school clubs, college clubs, sororities/ fraternities, civic and social clubs, businesses, faith-based institutions, Boy and Girl Scouts, and more! They choose an area in need or request suggestions from us.
